THEMES OF THE COMPETITION

The themes are listed as follows:

1. Farmers suicide in India.

Expectations from the participants: Factors contributing to Farmers suicide. A number of deaths occurred in 2–3 states – Statistics. Steps taken to prevent farmer suicide – How far have they been effective or is it just a phrase to be placed in the Party’s manifestos before elections. Critical analysis of all the Schemes and Yojanas framed. Even if the candidate focuses on an individual state along with sufficient enough statistics that would suffice the purpose. Suggestions and Recommendations.

2. Dream Food: The current Hunger situation in India.

Expectations from the participants: The current state of hunger in India, by analysing the different statistics provided by Government and different organization. The steps are taken

at the International and National level to deal with the issue. The status of the policies made by the government in this regard. Suggestions and Recommendations.

3. PUBG Ban: Is Aggression a valid Expression?

Highlighting the jurisprudence of banning such games, the participants are expected to show whether banning PUBG was a legitimate act of the state? Right to health/ peaceful environment/ public interest Vs Right to expression/ Right to make choices. Effects of PUBG in youth Negative/positive.

4. The Impact of Meme Culture on the Indian youth: A Pinnacle or Debacle?

The participants are expected to show the catalytic impact of meme culture in India, how the increasing use of Instagram and other social media platforms is fashioning the socialization stage of children, how it is used to foster political campaigning and advocate brazen views of religion [by normalizing them].

5. Structure of Higher Education in India.

Expectation from the participants: Identify the issues related to quality of higher education system, how higher education in India and employment is related, the role of higher education in development of a nation, what are issues and challenges in the higher education system of India, critical analysis of educated unemployed in India (the problem of half-baked graduates), recommendations and suggestions as to how quality of Indian higher education system can be improved.

- Participants can analyse the situation with the help of statistical data
- The participants while giving recommendations can take the examples of higher education system of other nations.

6. Article 370: A Vice or a Virtue?

Expectation from the participants: Analyse Article 370 in light of constitutional canons.

- The manuscript shall be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 300 words in MS-Word Document. The manuscript should be of 2000 to 3000 words.
- The contributors are permitted to submit a co-authored entry for the journal provided it should not exceed a maximum of **TWO** authors in each case.
- The journal strictly encourages and entertains Original work and any kind of plagiarism shall lead to disqualification of the paper.
- The contributors to the journal are requested to follow *ANY UNIFORM CITATION STYLE* for the article.
- The authors are requested to submit their work in:
 - Times New Roman Font
 - Font size for footnotes: 10
 - Font Size: 12
 - Line Spacing: 1.5
- All submissions must be accompanied by a **COVER LETTER** in a separate MS -Word Document with a *short introduction* of Author in not more than 200 words along with the Title of the Article, Author's full name, Affiliated Institution/College/University/School details and the Authors' Contact number and E-mail id.
- Submission are to be made in electronic form only and are to be sent to missionsangharsh@gmail.com
- The rest of the submission should not contain any reference to the identity of the author in order to enable anonymous screening and peer-review.
- Organization will reserve the exclusive publication right of the essays submitted by participants.
- All participants should strictly abide by the guidelines. Any deviance should lead to disqualification.
