B. <u>Guidelines regarding Classes and Examination of B.A.LL.B.(Hons.)</u>

Following are the guidelines regarding the classes and examination procedure of B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) Programme:

Classes

• The online classes will be held from <u>6th May 2020 to 15th June, 2020</u> for the evaluation and completion of syllabus.

Projects

The research project guidelines communicated by the University on 8th April 2020 (via email with subject 'Guidelines for Project Submission - Feb – June 2020 Semester') shall continue to be in force.

Attendance

5 Marks shall be awarded to all students for attendance

Examination Scheme (for Vth Year Batch)

Examination will be taken by the modes given below shall be of 70 marks. For V-Year students, given the project guidelines communicated on 8th April 2020, the examination marks shall be proportionately increased to be marked out of 95.

- **Take Home Exams:** Students will have 48 hours to submit responses to the questions. Critical to this option is drafting the questions in such a manner that accounts for the time and resources the students will have access to. It will be of 50 Marks exams.
- **Examination by Viva:** For ensuring that the online examination process is rigorous, faculty members can complement the online take home exams by conducting viva with individual students on the examination syllabus based on "Take Home Exams" through any online platform or phone calls. It will be of 20 Marks.

Examination Scheme (for I to IV Year Batches)

• Written End-Semester Examination (Only for I to IV Year): Whenever students return to campus as per the academic calendar below, the written examination will be conducted in classrooms as per usual procedures. This will be subject to any regulations the government might have in force at that point.

If the situation does not appear to be normal in view of Covid-19, the students can be assessed based on the following:

- a. Take Home Examination: 30 Marks (online).
- b. Project Marks: 40 Marks.
- c. Weighted average of the performance in the previous semesters: 25 Marks.

Note: The Scheme of classes, examination and academic calendar are based on the present state of affairs, the University reserves the rights to amend this, in the best interest of the institution and students, if the situation so warrants.
