About the Panel Discussion

Tough times call for renewed efforts to engage with both accumulated experience and new thinking around the key elements of the contemporary condition, if we are to effectively challenge the structures central to inequalities of gender, caste, class and community. The recurrent practices of ‘dishonouring’ women in the name of community honour, and the virulent attacks on her reproductive rights, do indeed appear to share features in common with sex selective abortion, albeit on a stridently personal front. Women’s reproductive rights studies have, from its inception, been committed to restore her dignity and existence as a basic condition for progression towards equality and emancipation. The adverse effects of the global status of women’s and girls’ sexual and reproductive health and rights are disturbing. The contemporary articulations of women’s rights from ability to access comprehensive sexuality education, control her own body, and access the health services she needs regardless of her sexuality, where she lives, her income level, or her ethnicity is a fundamental right., are all important issues before this Panel on **Reproductive Rights of Women in the Changing World: Expressing Autonomy of Choice.**
