- All essays must be written in English and the format specified below has to be strictly adhered to.
- Authorship is restricted to Single Author only.
- File type - All files submitted should be a PDF saved using the code allotted by the Organizers after closing of the registration.  
----Example: AI ESSAY01.pdf.
- Once the registration is over, the organisers will allot the participants with participants code and submission form link. The entries should be sent through this submission form only.
- Body - Times New Roman, size 12, line spacing 1.5, justified.
- Footnotes- Bluebook 20th edition rules of footnoting, Times New Roman, size 10, line spacing 1, left aligned.
- Endnotes are not to be used.
- Word limit for essay (inclusive of footnotes ) is a minimum of 3000 words and maximum of 3500 words.
- The body of the manuscript should not contain any personal details of the author, so as to enable anonymous screening. Any submissions which contain or hint at the personal details of the author shall be disqualified at the sole discretion of the Organisers of the Centre.
- The work submitted should be original and unpublished and must not be under simultaneous consideration for any other publication elsewhere.
- Plagiarised entries shall be rejected. The Organisers reserves the right to use any plagiarism checker to vet the submissions.
- The entries would be assessed on the basis of following criteria : Originality, Organisation and Style, Analysis and Substantive adequacy, and Bibliography.
- The Organisers has the sole discretion to accept or reject the submissions.
- The decision made by the Organisers will be final and binding in the competition.
