- 1. Abstracts should not exceed 350 words.
- 2.Format: Times New Roman, 12, spacing 1.5, Alignment Line 'justify', word format.
- 3. Include maximum 5 keywords.
- 4. Abstract should mention the following specific details on the front page:
 - Name of the Author
 - Affiliation
 - Designation
 - **Contact Number**
 - Email Id
 - Title of the Submission

GUIDELINES FOR RESEARCH PAPERS

- 1. Length of full paper: 2,500 5,000 words
- 2.Format: Times New Roman, 12, Line spacing 1.5, Alignment 'justify', word format
- 3. Footnotes: Font 'Times New Roman', Font Size 10, line spacing 1.5
- 4.Follow the Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation (20th Edition) for footnoting.
- 5. Submissions must be original and not yet published.
- 6. Co-authorship is allowed.
- 7. All authors must register separately.
