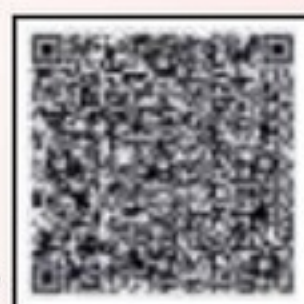

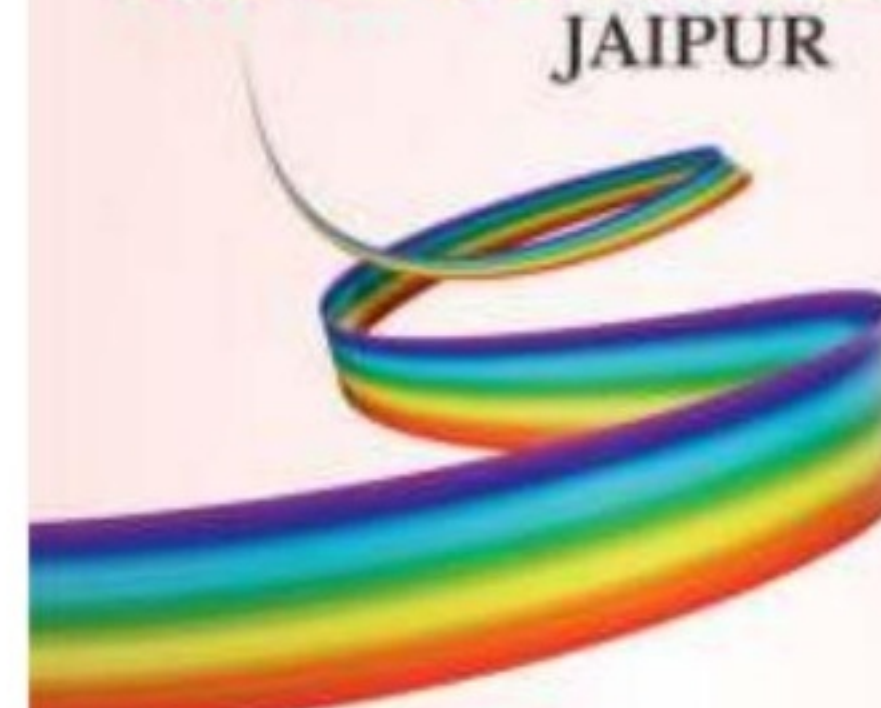

FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

The following guidelines should be followed:

1. The paper's word limit shall be 3000-4000 words (exclusive of footnotes).
2. The font style of the paper should be Times New Roman with font size being 12 for the main text and 10 for the footnotes.
3. The line spacing for the main text and footnotes should be 1.5 and 1 respectively. (End-notes are not permitted). One 1.5 Margin should be maintained on all four sides of the pages. Citation Style: Bluebook, 20th edition.
