# REGISTRATION

#### **PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION**

Universities shall provisionally register a slot for a team representing their University at the competition through the online form given **HERE**, on or before January 27, 2024.

#### FINAL REGISTRATION

All teams are required to register for Stage 1 of the competition, i.e., Memorial Evaluation Rounds, on or before January 30, 2024.

Teams are required to pay a registration fee of INR 2,500/- for completing registration for Stage 1 of the competition via online bank transfer as per the details intimated to Universities after provisional registration.

The teams qualifying for Stage 2 of the competition, i.e., oral rounds, shall be further required to pay an accommodation charge of INR 4,000/- as per details intimated to qualifying teams.
